Gallion, State Auditor, presented the State Auditor's office plans for contracting for services during the 2021-23 biennium, including a request for approval to charge the Public Employees Retirement System for the cost of hiring a consultant to assist in the writing of a request for proposal relating to the performance audit of prescription drug coverage.

It was moved by Representative Kempenich, seconded by Representative O'Brien, and carried on a roll call vote that the State Auditor's office may use up to 10 percent of the \$375,000 authorized by the Legislative Assembly in House Bill No. 1004 (2021) to hire a consultant to assist with the request for proposal relating to the performance audit of prescription drug coverage and to charge the Public Employees Retirement System for the cost. Senators Klein, Clemens, Heckaman, and Kannianen, and Representatives Adams, Christensen, Johnson, Kempenich, Magrum, Nathe, O'Brien, Schmidt, and Trottier voted "aye." No negative votes were cast.
