1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to wearing fluorescent pink or certain camouflage patterns while hunting big game.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-05-06.** Big game hunters to wear <u>solid or camouflage</u> daylight fluorescent

7 orange <u>or fluorescent pink</u> garments - Exception - Penalty.

8 Every person, while hunting big game, shall wear a head covering and an outer garment

9 above the waistline, both of daylight fluorescent orange <u>or fluorescent pink</u> color, totaling four

10 hundred square inches [2580.64 square centimeters] or more of solid fluorescent orange color,

- 11 solid fluorescent pink color, or a camouflage pattern of at least fifty percent fluorescent orange
- 12 <u>or fluorescent pink</u>, and both to be worn conspicuously on the person. This section does not
- 13 apply to any person hunting big game with bow and arrow during special bow hunting seasons.

14 Any person who violates this section is guilty of a class 2 noncriminal offense.
