(3	Was separated from employment with the most recent employer for reasons	
	directly attributable to domestic violence, stalking, or sexual assault <u>; or</u>	
<u>(4</u>	) Is a military spouse who voluntarily left the most recent employment to	
	relocate because of permanent change of station orders of the individual's	
	military-connected spouse.

7	<u>(2)</u>	"Permanent change of station orders" means the assignment,
8		reassignment, or transfer of a member of the armed forces of the United
9		States or a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States
10		from the member's present duty station or location without return to the
11		previous duty station or location.
