- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

All fees collected by the state historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04 are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION. All gifts, grants, devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society and

ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS 5 FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of 6 \$1,400,000\$4,200,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund for the purpose of 7 providing funding for historic site and extraordinary repairs. 8 SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT. 9 The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, includes \$100,000 of grant funding from 10 the department of transportation for the purpose of defraying expenses for the Lewis and Clark
