The Senate provided funding for salary increases of 2 percent on July 1, 2021, with a monthly minimum of $\$ 80$ and a monthly maximum of $\$ 300$, and a 2 percent increase on July 1, 2022.
    ${ }^{2}$ An administrative assistant position and relating funding is removed, of which $\$ 159,486$ is for salaries and wages and $\$ 35,450$ is for operating expenses. The Senate added the position, the same as the executive budget.
