- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the commissioner of
- 2 university and school lands; to provide for distributions from permanent funds; to provide a
- 3 report; and to provide an exemption.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys from special funds derived from the state lands maintenance fund in the state treasury, to the commissioner of university and school lands for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commissioner of university and school lands, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

14	SECTION 3. DISTRIBUTIONS TO STATE INSTITUTIONS. Pursuant to article IX of the			
15	Constitution of North Dakota, the board of university and school lands shall distribute during the			
16	biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, the following amounts, from the			
17	permanent funds managed for the benefit of the following entities:

The amounts 4 previously appropriated from the oil and gas impact grant fund and identified in sections 2 and 9 5 of chapter 13 of the 2019 Session Laws related to the oil and gas impact grant fund, including 6 any grant awards returned to the fund, are not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended 7 amounts are available for grants and administrative expenses associated with the fund during 8 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. 9 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROJECT - REPORT. The 10 \$3,600,000 appropriated from the state lands maintenance fund in section 1 of chapter 38 of the 11 2017 Session Laws and identified in section 10 of chapter 13 of the 2019 Session Laws is not 12 subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds are available to complete the 13 information technology project during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 14 2023. During the 2021-22 interim, the commissioner of university and school lands shall provide 15 at least one report to the information technology committee regarding the status of the 16 information technology project.
