- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the state's developmental
- 2 disability services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

5 SERVICES. During the 2021-22 interim, the legislative management shall study state and

6 federal laws and regulations relating to the care and treatment of individuals with developmental7 disabilities.

- 8 1. The study must include a review of the following:
- 9 a. The state's existing programs to identify potential pathways for individuals who
 10 have a developmental disability but do not meet the eligibility criteria for existing
 11 programs;
- b. Gap identification with programmatic recommendations identifying potential
 strategies to address the gaps, and potential federal and state funding sources
 including the federal Medicaid 1915(i) waiver;
- c. Efforts and services offered by other states, including the planning and
 implementation process for any new programs; and
- 17 d. The impact of implementation and expanding of programs to address service
 18 gaps, including the number of individuals impacted, cost, and timeline for
 19 implementation.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
 with any legislation necessary to implement those recommendations, to the
 sixty-eighth legislative assembly.
