1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying the
2	administrative rules process, including a review of any relevant statutes regarding
3	administrative rules to determine if any statutes are unclear or ambiguous, the degree to which
4	agencies are complying with the process, which state agencies are specifically exempt from the
5	process, and if those state agencies should remain exempt.
6	WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly has authorized administrative agencies to adopt
7	administrative rules through the administrative rules process outlined in North Dakota Century
8	Code Chapter 28-32; and
9	WHEREAS, upon becoming effective, administrative rules have the force and effect of law;

11	WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly specifically has exempted at least 20 state agencies
2	from the administrative rules process; and
3	WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly should review the specifically exempted state
4	agencies and determine if those state agencies should remain exempt from the administrative
5	rules process; and
6	WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly periodically should review any relevant statutes
7	regarding administrative rules to determine if any statutes are unclear or ambiguous; and
8	WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly should study and review the administrative rules
9	process to determine whether administrative agencies are implementing legislative purpose and
20	intent properly and the degree to which agencies are complying with the process;
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
22	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
23	That the Legislative Management consider studying the administrative rules process,
24	including a review of any relevant statutes regarding administrative rules to determine if any
25	statutes are unclear or ambiguous, the degree to which state agencies are complying with the
