- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to health insurance utilization reports.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - Once each calendar year, any employer with fifty-one or more eligible employees or upon termination of health insurance coverage for any employer, the employer is entitled to a report from the insurer or administrator of that employer's employee health plan which includes a:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>A</u> monthly accounting for the most recent twenty-four-month period of the total number of insured or covered employees <u>and dependents by class of coverage</u>, the total premiums paid, and the totalseparate totals of the medical and <u>prescription drug</u> benefits paid on behalf of the employer's health plan.
 - b. An accounting of high-dollar medical and prescription drug claims paid for employees and dependents. For purposes of this subdivision, "high-dollar medical and prescription drug claims" means the total amount of claims paid for an employee or dependent during each twelve-month period of the most recent twenty-four-month period equal to or exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars. The accounting must also include the current status of coverage for any employees and dependents with high-dollar claims.
 - <u>A current census of employees and dependents covered under the employer's health plan.</u>
