- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to health insurance utilization reports; and to declare an
- 3 <u>emergency</u>.

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 26.1-36.4-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 1. Once each calendar year, any employer with fifty-onetwenty-six or more eligible employees, any employer investigating becoming part of a health plan, including a plan sponsored by an association or a multiple employer welfare arrangement, or any employer upon termination of health insurance coverage for any employer, the employer is entitled to a report from the insurer or administrator of that employer's employee health plan which includes a:
  - a. A monthly accounting for the most recent twenty-four-month period of the total number of insured or covered employees and dependents by class of coverage, the total premiums paid, and the total separate totals of the medical and prescription drug benefits paid on behalf of the employer's health plan Annual data for the previous three years on the premiums paid by the employer and the claims paid by the insurer or administrator.
  - b. An accounting of high-dollar medical and prescription drug claims paid for employees and dependents. For purposes of this subdivision, "high-dollar medical and prescription drug claims" means the total amount of claims paid for an employee or dependent during each twelve-month period of the most recent twenty-four-month period equal to or exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars. 2	and dependents with high-dollar claims.
3	<u>C.</u> A current census of employees and dependents covered under the employer's
4	health plan.
5	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
