- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state or local government entity may not:
- 8 <u>a. Substantially burden a person's exercise of religion unless applying the burden to</u>
  9 <u>that person's exercise of religion in a particular situation is essential to further a</u>
  10 <u>compelling governmental interest and is the least restrictive means of furthering</u>
  11 <u>that compelling government interest;</u>
  - - c. Treat religious conduct more restrictively than any comparable secular conduct because of alleged economic need or benefit.
- 2. A person claiming to be aggrieved by a violation of this section may assert that
  violation as a claim or defense in a judicial proceeding and obtain appropriate relief,
  including costs and reasonable attorney's fees.
