## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

EXTENSION SERVICE - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT. During the period-beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending October 1, 2024, the North Dakota state-university extension service shall conduct a needs assessment of projected soil conservation-buildings, infrastructure, vehicles, equipment, and software needs for the next ten years. The North Dakota state university extension service shall consult with the state soil conservation-committee for the purposes of this section. The North Dakota state university extension service-shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative management by October 1, 2024.

## SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SOIL CONSERVATION

**DISTRICTS.** During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the structure, function, operation, infrastructure, and needs of the soil conservation districts. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
