A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
society.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, as follows:

12 SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION. All gifts, grants,

13 devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society and

14 deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the state

15 historical society for the purposes provided in section 55-01-04, for the biennium beginning

16 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
