HOUSE BILL NO. 1291
(Representative Dockter)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 28-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to execution of a judgment.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 28-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

## 28-21-01. Execution at any time within tentwenty years.

A judgment creditor or the party's duly appointed personal representatives at any time within tentwenty years after the entry of judgment may proceed to enforce the judgment by execution as provided in this chapter. If the judgment creditor in a mortgage foreclosure does not proceed within sixty days after entry of judgment in the foreclosure to serve a special execution and proceed without delay to a sheriff's sale, any other lienholder or other interested person may obtain the special execution and proceed to arrange for a sheriff's sale.
