

## **CHAPTER 31-02 EXAMINATION OF ADVERSE PARTIES**

**31-02-01. Action for discovery abolished - Provisions of chapter exclusive.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rule 27(c).

**31-02-02. Cross-examination of adverse party on trial of civil matter - Conclusiveness of testimony.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rule 43(b).

**31-02-03. Examination of adverse party before trial - Notice - Reference - Compelling attendance.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rule 26(a), now Rules 30(a), 31(a).

**31-02-04. Taking and filing of testimony of examination before trial required - Readable in evidence by whom.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rule 26(d), now Rules 32(a), 32(c), and Rule 26(f).

**31-02-05. Refusal to testify punishable as contempt and pleading may be stricken.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rules 37(b), (d).

**31-02-06. Party may be examined on own behalf.** Superseded by N.D.R.Civ.P., Rules 26(a), 27(a), 43(b), now Rules 30(a), 31(a), 27(a), 43(b).
