- Round I Tribal State Grant
  - Grant Objectives:
    - Expand current **CDL** 16-week training program
    - Expand and Enhance current 18-month **Electrical** program
    - Developed an **Oil Field Operations** training program
    - To deliver entrepreneurship through education/training, guidance and assistance to all participant in developing small business.
  
- Round II Tribal State Grant Expansion
  - Expansion of the Oil Field Operations program that was previously approved in Round I of the Tribal State Grant.
  
  - Expansion Objectives:
    - Expand the **Welding** credential that is identified as part of the oilfield curriculum and to increase enrollment.
      - Installation of portable ventilation control units allowed the college to increase the number of welding lab stations.
      - An additional instructor was hired. The additional instructor has allow more emphasis to be placed on practical lab experience which results in actual competency as welders
      - Additionally, it would allow TMCC to have an additional ten students enrolled
  
- Round III Tribal State Grant Expansion
  - Expansion of the CDL/HEO training program that was previously approved in Round I of the Tribal State Grant.
  
  - Expansion Objectives:
    - Expand CDL/HEO program credentials to include Skid Loader and Rough Terrain Telehandler certification
    - Expand the CDL programs Class A driver’s license endorsements that includes purchasing additional driving scenarios for our CDL virtual driving simulator

## GRANT GOALS

- Objective 1: During the grant, the **Oil Field Operations** training will provide training to **50 individuals with 80% (40) students receiving certificates** of completion and/or receiving industry certification and **60% (24)** being placed in employment, additional education or military.
- Included in Objective 1: to expand the **Welding** credential, **10 additional welding students** to be enrolled as a result of the approved grant expansion.
  - Oil Field Operations training being offered first time summer session 2015.
    - Fifteen (15) new students currently enrolled.
  - Eight (8) Welding students earned their 9-month Welding Certificate May 2014.
    - 100% of Welders received ND State Welding Certification.
    - 100% of Welders received OSHA 10 Certification.
    - Three (3) Welders received Hazwoper Certification.
    - **Placement**: Three (3) Welders currently employed full-time.
    - **Placement**: One (1) Welder continued enrollment in the summer Advance Pipe Welding training.
- Objective 2: During the grant, the **CDL/Heavy Equipment Operator** program will provide training to **30 individuals with 80% (24) receiving certificates** of completion and/or receiving industry certification and **60% (14)** being placed in employment, additional education or military.
  - Twenty (20) CDL students have successfully completed the CDL/HEO program and earned a Class A Driver's License.
    - 100% of the 20 CDL students received 16- week Certificates.
    - 100% of the 20 CDL students earned OSHA 10 Certification.
    - 50% of the 20 CDL student earned H2S Gas Certification.
    - **Placement**: Eight (8) of the students have obtained employment.

(Note: 12 of the 20 CDL students only recently completed the CDL program on May 16, 2014)
  - Six (6) new CDL students are currently enrolled summer session 2014.
- Objective 3: During the grant, the **Electrical** program will provide training to **16 individuals with 80% (13) receiving certificates** of completion and/or industry certification and **60% (9)** being placed in employment, additional education or military.
  - Fourteen (14) Electrical Students have earned 9-month Certificates.
    - 100% NCCER National Registry Certified.
  - **Placement**: Nine (9) Students Currently Summer Employed.
  - All 14 students have indicated they plan to return Fall Semester 2014 to complete the second year A.A.S. Electrical Program
