Dear Mr. Walstad:

I am writing to inform you of a legislative change affecting the need for an existing rule. N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 69-06-03, which covers letters of intent in siting cases, implements N.D.C.C. § 49-22-07.1. North Dakota's 63rd Legislative Assembly passed House Bill No. 1147, an act that, amongst other things, repealed section 49-22-07.1 relating to letters of intent.

Because the law implemented by N.D. Admin Code Chapter 69-06-03 has now been repealed we request that the Legislative Council repeal N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 69-06-03. Under N.D.C.C. § 28-32-06, the statute authorizing the Public Service Commission to implement the state's siting laws no longer includes any reference to letters of intent, the rule is no longer warranted.
