Presentation to Legislature on January 26, 2016

NEW FACILITY

Currently Burleigh County and Morton County are in the process of building a new facility on the SE corner of Bismarck.

The facility will initially house 476 with one pod being shelled in for future use.

The new facility is expected to be completed by late spring 2017.

CURRENT INMATE NUMBERS

On Friday (January 22) we took a snap shot of our inmate population, the following is what we discovered;

1. 184 in custody
2. Of these 184;
 - a. 27 were sentenced
 - b. 43 were being housed in other facilities
 - c. 5 being held for US Marshall
 - d. 2 being held for others
3. Then a further breakdown of charges are:
 - a. Ranges from Murder to Petty theft
 - b. 72 were in on some form of drug related charges
 - i. Of the 72, 13 were on probation violations only
 - ii. Of the 72, 18 were on drug charges only, ranging from possession to possession with intent to deliver
 - iii. Of the 72, 41 had drug related charges as well as other charges, to include robbery, fleeing, child neglect, burglary, domestic violence aggravated assault, possession of firearms, forgery theft of property

2015 STATISTICS

We spent \$ 738,527 to house inmates in other facilities during 2015

We housed inmates in 9 other North Dakota Counties, Bismarck Transition Center and Walworth County (Selby) South Dakota

Our highest one day total number of inmates was in August at 216

In August of 2015 we average 60 inmates per day housed outside of our facility

HOUSING FOR OTHER ENTITIES

During 2015 we housed for other agencies as well, here is a breakdown

1. We housed for 7 other agencies outside of Bismarck
 - a. Kidder County, Emmons County, Lincoln Police, Parole & Probation, Dept of Corrections, Bureau of Prisons & US Marshal Service
 - b. It should be noted that we have 50,370 inmate days available per year
 - c. We had a total of 3,363 housing for others in 2015
 - d. US Marshall Service utilized the most nights (3041) for a daily average of 8.3 inmates
 - e. In 2015 we used 6.7 % of total possible days of housing for others
