


**North Dakota Community Action Partnership Testimony****RE: Health Services Committee, Dental Services Study****April 13, 2016****Submitted by Andrea Olson, Executive Director**

Madame Chairwoman and Members of the Committee, thank you for allowing me the opportunity to testify today. My name is Andrea Olson and I serve as Executive Director for the North Dakota Community Action Partnership.

Let me just take a quick moment to let you know a little bit about Community Action. There are seven Community Action Agencies across the state and we operate programs that enable North Dakota residents' opportunities to secure and maintain self-sufficiency. We serve all 53 counties across the state and some of our programs include Head Start, Weatherization, Sportsmen Against Hunger, and Volunteer Tax Assistance. Each of the agencies belong to a membership organization, the North Dakota Community Action Partnership.

Community Action Agencies are primarily funded by the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funding. The funds are funneled from Office of Community Services (OCS) to the North Dakota Department of Commerce who allocates it to each of our agencies via a funding formula based on poverty. We work very closely with Commerce and they manage the funding for us. OCS requires Community Action to adhere to reporting requirements and organizational performance standards. The standards we're required to follow were implemented last year and one of the components is conducting a needs assessment. Late last year, we conducted an assessment in conjunction with Commerce and that is the focus of my testimony.

The needs assessment asked a series of questions soliciting information related to low-income issues such as employment support, emergency services, and child and family development. The assessment also asked the participants to describe their miscellaneous needs they've identified in their communities.



As you can see on pages 75-79, dental service was the second highest need that was identified statewide when participants were asked to identify miscellaneous needs.


Respondents wrote:

- *Dental care is not readily available and many people come the clinic or ER for dental problems because they can't afford a dentist. There are multiple barriers for people needing dental care and are in an urgent, painful situation or they need major dental work now and there are long waits for dental care.*
- *need help with dental service bad*
- *the need is dental and prescription glasses*
- *some services aren't as important as others but are up there but definitely need medical such as eyes, dental, and all over health*
- *low income need help with car repairs, dental care and legal services*
- *dental and legal to not serve low income families*
- *dental providers who will accept Medicaid*

North Dakota Community Action Partnership would be thrilled to see hygienists be able to expand their scope of practice. We feel it would provide a great benefit to people in need and would prevent them from seeking expensive emergency care via the emergency room and other urgent care facilities.
