


# DISTANCE EDUCATION (DE) ENROLLMENT

# Distance Education Enrollments

- In the following slides, the data focuses on DE enrollments rather than DE courses.
- Data presented are institutionally reported DE enrollments to IPEDS for Fall term 2016.
- DE courses within the NDUS system are difficult to capture:
  - Courses are defined as a minimum of 50% of content is delivered via distance delivery , including internet, IVN, correspondence, and courses taught on-site at remote location.
  - Some courses are comprised of two sections (on-site & IVN) to accommodate both on campus and IVN students within the same course. (One course will appear as two in the data system).

# DISTANCE EDUCATION SERVES NORTH DAKOTA


- 47% of all NDUS Students take at least one DE course
  - 40% of degree seeking students
  - 82% of non-degree seeking students
- 69% of all NDUS Students taking at least one Distance Education course are ND Residents
- 61% of all NDUS Students who are taking only Distance Education courses are ND Residents

# PERCENTAGE OF “EXCLUSIVELY DE” STUDENTS WHO ARE ND RESIDENTS


- **Community Colleges: 78%**


Community Colleges - All Students



Community Colleges - Degree Seeking




Community Colleges - Non Degree Seeking




# REGIONAL 4-YEAR DISTANCE ED. 2015




Regional Universities - All Students



Regional Universities - Degree Seeking




Regional Universities - Non Degree Seeking


