

## **Behavioral Health Internships**

This report is a response to the 13 July 2016 request from the Interim Health Services Committee for a presentation regarding:

- Number of internships available each year to behavioral health-related students and graduates, including funding sources;
- Role of universities in arranging internships; and,
- Number of behavioral health graduates each year and states where North Dakota graduates are completing internship training.

The report summarizes internships in behavioral health academic programs using the best available data. The vast-majority of internships are arranged on a case-by-case basis with students. Thus it is not possible to present a list of all internships that might be available. As an alternative, this report presents information on the internships that have been filled. Lists of specific internships have been included as appendices when possible.

**Appendix 3: UND Social Work (B.S.W. and M.S.W.) Placements**

**Challenges:**

- There is some concern within agencies regarding their ability to offer supervision time or a good student experience based on high caseloads or lack of staff time in general.
- Clinical placements for graduate students can be a challenge – from both public and private sectors – due to pressure to produce billable hours, and a student intern cannot bill. Difficult to make time to supervise a student and meet productivity goals within the agency.
- Not as many agencies as there are students in the GFK area (especially BSSW), and students don't want to travel because of expenses.
- Some agencies that could provide suitable placements do not have qualified social workers (2+ years post graduate experience) on staff to supervise students.
- There is no payment for providing a placement. Agencies and supervisors do this without compensation. Most take interns as a give-back to the profession i.e. someone took the time to supervise them.

**Opportunities:**

- In general, most agencies are willing and able to host social work interns. They recognize that we are training a new work force for them.
- Internships can be a great ‘interview’ process for the agency, as many of our student interns are offered employment upon the completion of the internship.

**Appendix 5: UND Counseling Psychiatry (Ph.D.) Placement**

**Comment: Challenges:** *There are only three accredited doctoral internship sites in North Dakota, and students across the country are competitive for those sites. There are also a limited number of doctoral practicum sites—a clinical (training) placement for doctoral students that is much like an internship and comes before the yearlong internship requirement. The reason for this shortage is the limited number of psychologists willing serve as site supervisors for free, and the lack of funding from state and university resources so that we could hire supervisors at high need sites. These potential sites include substance use intervention sites and sites in rural communities.*

**Opportunities:** *We have highly qualified students who could provide quality services (including assessment and prevention services) at sites around the state of North Dakota, but lack resources to pay for site supervisors. Our students also have the option to be trained in telehealth services, an outstanding resource to provide needed services to remote parts of the state.*

However, the post-graduate internship that is required for licensure has been a different story. While students can find internships in the Fargo area, it has been harder outside the greater Fargo area as some agencies don't believe that MFT's meet state requirements even though we have been licensed in ND for over 10 years.

## Appendix 12: UND Clinical Psychology (PhD) Placements

Our PhD in Clinical Psychology (the entry-level degree for licensed Psychologists in ND) requires two basic types of supervised predoctoral clinical experiences.

- The first, **Clinical Practica**, are completed by students after their first year but before their final year of graduate training. Students typically complete two years of paid ½-time (16-20 hours per week) formal practicum (PSYC 587), and have the option to complete additional ¼-time (8-10 hrs per week) unpaid practica, with approval of their adviser and the program. In addition, students are required to complete three full years of Practicum at the Psychological Services Center, our training clinic (PSYC 580). PhD students must be supervised by licensed Psychologists, though the department does not pay supervisors (in some cases, the supervisors are UND employees who either volunteer their time or do supervision as part of their contract; in most cases, however, supervisors are compensated by some external entity, or volunteer their time). The majority of practica are supported by entities outside of UND, and most of these entities are private clinics (see below). While more than a decade ago, many of the external practica were through state agencies (e.g., HSCs), this is no longer the case. Unfortunately, private providers cannot get insurance reimbursement for services provided by supervised PhD students (except for assessment/testing), meaning that most experience with psychological intervention must either occur through state-funded agencies (UND's UCC, Tri-County Corrections, etc.), which are shrinking in numbers, or they must volunteer their time at a private clinic. Because UND does not offer GSAs for all students in their 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years of training, paid practicum sites are essential to the program's marketability (the most qualified students tend to gravitate toward programs that offer them the most money!). In any given year, the program must place 12-16 students at paid practica, and we typically place additional students at ¼-time unpaid practica.
- The second, **Clinical Predoctoral Internship**, is required for all APA-accredited PhD programs, and consists of a 1-year, full time, paid clinical experience at an APA-accredited internship site, somewhere in the US. The Internship is most comparable to a medical Residency for Physicians in training, in that there is a standardized nation-wide application process, and experience requires, in most cases, relocation by the student. Currently, there are only three accredited predoctoral internship sites in ND (UND University Counseling Center, Fargo VA Medical System, & Southeast HSC). While our program places students all over the US on internship, we have placed students at each of these three ND internships in the past. On average, the program must place 6-7 students each year with an accredited internship.
- A full-time one-year APPIC (Association of Psychology Postdoctoral and Internship Centers) *Internship* must be secured and completed in order to graduate with a Clinical Psych PhD.
- In order to apply for an *Internship*, students must list clinical hours earned on predoctoral *Practica*. The more assessment and intervention hours earned on practica, the more competitive the applicant is for internship.
- Therefore, Practica that afford significant hours in both *intervention* AND *assessment* are critical for graduation and eventual licensure. Typically, more *intervention* hours (psychotherapy, behavioral interventions, etc.) are needed than *assessment*.

The program relies on paid practica for support of students in their third and fourth year of training. While private sector clinics may get third-party reimbursement for *assessments* and assessment services performed by graduate students (e.g., psychological testing), this is

typically not the case for *interventions*. As a result, assessment hours are typically earned in private clinics (e.g., CPEA, ATAGF, Midwest Neuro, Sanford Neuro, etc.), while intervention hours are earned at sites funded by the state (Life Skills Transitions Center in Grafton, UND's University Counseling Center, Psychological Services Center, etc.). The number and variety of state-funded placements has significantly dwindled, owing to a disinvestment in student training opportunities and recent budget contractions. For example, ND's Human Service Centers used to offer many paid placements for PhD students that provided significant assessment and intervention hours; currently, there are no funded HSC practica, and no funding for licensed staff Psychologists to offer supervision. Until this year, the ND Department of Corrections offered funded placements at both their James River and Bismarck facilities; these placements were recently defunded. As a result, students now typically volunteer additional time to get their critical intervention hours. Moreover, the loss of funded intervention experiences has resulted in fewer students providing services in the community, as was done in the past through all of the ND Human Service Centers, and more recently, through the state prisons at Bismarck and Jamestown (now defunded).

### **Opportunities:**

North Dakota could alleviate this problem in two ways.

- First, it could require that insurance reimburse student intervention work at rough parity with reimbursement for *intervention* services provided by Psychology Residents and Psychologists; this would allow private sector clinics to offer supervised *intervention* experiences to PhD students, and expand the services available to the public through the private sector.
- Second, given that PhD students are far cheaper than licensed Psychologists, ND could mandate that the various Human Service Centers offer funded practicum experiences for PhD students, and allow licensed supervisors time in their schedules for supervision. This would likewise expand the mental health services available in the state. Moreover, the state could fund tele mental health initiatives at its HSCs, and employ PhD practica students to offer distance services.
