The North Dakota Community Corrections Association is a non-profit organization made up of thirteen community service offices located across North Dakota and exist with the primary goal to provide supervision and community service opportunities to offenders ordered to complete community service by court order or per supervised probation agreement. The NDCCA members provided additional services such as drug/alcohol testing, victim impact panels, supervision of low risk probation offenders, and Theft Awareness & Prevention seminars depending upon what the need is in their community.

Mission Statement

Community Corrections Programs are strategically placed statewide in an effort to enhance community partnerships while providing community based alternatives to detention. The community based alternatives focus on protecting society, addressing the concerns of crime victims, and providing supervision to offenders in the community. More specifically, all community service programs are to have a coordinated office which provides:

- 1) Alternatives to Incarceration
- 2) Repayment to the community for inappropriate or unlawful behavior
- 3) A positive support system

What is Community Service and what role does NDCCA assume?

Community service is unpaid work performed for non-profit organizations or government entities. The NDCCA's role as it relates to community service is to monitor offenders who are ordered to completed community service and report back to the referring agency as to the offender's success.

Benefits of Community Service

- Offender remains in the community so they may continue to be employed
- The offender's family unit remains intact
- The debt to society is repaid by an offender volunteering his/her time at local non-profit organizations
- Potential for all community service offenders to learn new job skills based upon their work-site placement
- An alternative to incarceration so jai

NDCCA Recidivism Study Highlights

- 945 clients referred to NDCCA agencies to complete community service hours
- Within a six month time frame (7/1/15 – 12/31/15) clients completed 15,851 hours of community service
- An estimated savings of \$126,791 in jail costs across North Dakota between 7/1/15 – 12/31/15
 - Based on one (1) day in jail is equivalent to ten hours of community service and an estimated cost of \$80 per day to house one inmate in jail
- Out of the 945 clients referred to the NDCCA...
 - 71% of the clients were male and 29% were female
 - 37% of the clients had at least a high school diploma while 32% had some college education
 - 54% of the clients were referred by district courts across while 43% were referred by municipal courts
 - 94% of the crimes committed were misdemeanor offenses
 - 4% of the referred clients had committed a violent offense; 15% had committed a drug offense; 17% were convicted of Driving Under the Influence (of alcohol); 26% committed an offense listed under the "other category" which could consist of theft of property, false statement to law enforcement, disorderly conduct, etc.; and 38% committed an alcohol related offense (not including DUI) such as Minor In Consumption/Possession.
 - As of December 31, 2015; 65% of the client cases were closed successfully since they completed their community service, 23% of those client cases were still open, and only 12% were closed unsuccessfully due to the client failing to complete their hours.
