

SECTION 1. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES STUDY OF MEDICAID AND MEDICAID EXPANSION COST-SHARING PROVISIONS.

During the 2015-16 interim, the department of human services shall study options for implementing income-based cost-sharing provisions for the medicaid and medicaid expansion programs. This study must include consideration of provider recovery rates for copayments, information technology capacity for implementing income-based cost-sharing provisions, consideration of how income-based cost-sharing has been implemented by other states, analysis of the costs and benefits of cost-sharing, and consideration of whether cost-sharing improves the effectiveness of medicaid and medicaid expansion programs. Before July 1, 2016, the department of human services shall report to the legislative management the outcome of the study and the associated legislative recommendations and related draft legislation.
