Xcess Load Permit - Over 150,000 lbs GVW

The Heavy Weight Fee Schedule is not applicable on loads over 150,000 lbs. (Xcess Loads). On Xcess Loads the fee is \$5 per ton per mile driven on county roads, on weight over 105,500 lbs.

- No self-issue permits are allowed on Xcess loads. EPermits must be used - ndenergy.org.

- Up to 2 business-day waiting period required.

Formula Example:

$$300,000 \text{ lb. GVW} - 105,500 = 194,500$$

$$194,500 \div 2,000 = 97.25 \text{ Tons}$$

$$97.25 \text{ Tons} \times \$5.00 = \$486.25/\text{mile}$$

Uniform Permits are NOT authority to use county roads if road has been weight restricted by county. Contact the Sheriff's Dept. or County Road Superintendent in each county before using any weight-restricted county road.
