Senate Bill No. 2238 - Department of Public Instruction - Senate Action

This bill provides a general fund appropriation of \$450,000 to the Superintendent of Public Instruction to reimburse school districts for costs related to providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation training to students.

Senate Bill No. 2238 - Department of Public Instruction - House Action

The House did not change the Senate appropriation, but provided reimbursement is available to nonpublic schools and required schools provide in-kind or cash match to receive reimbursement.
