RE: HB 1381 – Commencement of Term for County Officer

In all three sections of this bill, the words "or within ten days thereafter" are eliminated.

For all other elected positions, the beginning date of an official's term of office is clearly stated as starting on a specific day.

However, for reasons we have been unable to find, the law dating back many years provided county officials with a beginning range of days. While the law stated a specific beginning date for a county official's term of office, it also allowed the term to begin "or within ten days thereafter".

RE: HB 1381 – Commencement of Term for County Officer

For reasons we have been unable to find, the law dating back for many years provided county officials with a beginning range of days when their term of office began. That is, "or within ten days thereafter".

Therefore, in all three sections of this bill, the words "or within ten days thereafter" are eliminated.

In addition, rather than having a specific beginning date, e.g., December 1, January 1, the beginning date of the official's term was the first Monday of the designated month.

Therefore, in all three section of this bill, the beginning date of an official's term of office is clearly stated as the 1st day of the month.
