Chairman Johnson opened the hearing for HCR 3047.

Rep. Onstad: House Concurrent Resolution 3047 lines out the request to have LC study grain inspection and grading procedures.

The first part of the WHEREAS states it is to ensure that producers get paid the maximum amount for their grain according to its quality.

This also asks for the inspection and grading procedures include the methodology, accuracy, uniformity and cost-effectiveness of the procedures and the process for resolving disputes.

This will eliminate different standards in place from year to year and will give more consistency from warehouse to warehouse.

The people who came to me initially wanted me to draft a bill. I did go to the grain dealers and they were not comfortable with the wording of the bill. I then went back to the person and told them that they will not get support for this bill and he accepted this HCR,
