Minutes:

Senator Gary Lee opened the hearing on SB 2351 relating to exhibition driving.

Senator Potter introduced the bill and talked about the law enforcement officer that was in and testified before the committee when they tried to put this bill as an amendment to another. It was suggested that instead of putting the exhibition driving as an amendment that it have its own bill. Senator Potter said he did not have a problem with the bill.

Senator Fiebiger asked about section 4, "driving a vehicle in a manner that results in a vehicle's tire leaving the surface of the highway." He asked if this was a wide spread problem.

Senator Potter said he had never seen any one doing it but it was a concern of the officer that testified on the amendment. His concern was that when your wheels leave the surface, you are no longer in control of the vehicle. Senator Potter said the officer's frustration was that law enforcement really couldn't do anything about this behavior. Senator Potter said he did contact ABATE that it was on the agenda.

Senator Lee closed the hearing on SB 2351.
