

Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

Relating to the international registration plan and the unified carrier registration system

Mr. Timothy J Dawson Legislative Council staffed the interim Transportation Committee here to describe this bill, not for or against the bill. This bill relates to the international registration plan, the unified carrier registration system and the single state insurance registration system. This is all cleanup language. In section 1 lines 16-17, when that language was put in last session it should have been put in section 2 of the bill as well relating to the registration of a vehicle. That language is parroted again in Section 2 lines 17-18. There are some states that don't have a reciprocal excise tax agreement with this state, such as Montana, Alaska, Oregon, New Hampshire, and Delaware. So that makes those two sections read together fairly well. The next change is in section 3 relating to the unified carrier registration system, the program that no longer exists is being overstruck and in the next section there is a repeal of the single state insurance registration system which also has been rolled in to the unified carrier registration system. Since the feds simplified that we simplified our law as well. The general gist of the unified carrier registration system is that if you go into interstate commerce to have those registration fees apportioned among the states you drive in.

Linda Sitz, Director of Motor Vehicle Division North Dakota Department of Transportation (DOT) in support, attached testimony #1.

Daniel L. Rouse Legal Counsel to the N. D. Office of the State Tax Commissioner's Office the Unified Carrier Registration System is part of a national organization that recognizes registers and enforces regulations with respect to interstate transportation (the big trucks). This is a federal plan.

Mr. Chairman and members of the committee - I'm Linda Sitz, Director of the Motor Vehicle Division at the North Dakota Department of Transportation (DOT). Thank you for giving me the opportunity to present information to you today.

The NDDOT had the opportunity to work with the committee during the interim and is in agreement with the suggested bill changes.

This bill amends section 39-19-06 of state law and brings it into compliance with federal law which was originally passed in 2005 pertaining to the Unified Carriers Registration (UCR). The bill cleans up language to harmonize State law with Federal law.
