Rep. Thoreson We made that move around 2003 or 2004. There was about a four or five year probationary period where we were not eligible for post season activity. That is part of the move. The first year we went into post season eligibility, we came close to it that year. Since then we have dominated the playoff system in the years since. This has brought forward discussion of should we stay at this level or move up to the next level. I think we are doing just fine where we are.

Chairman Kasper Have you been able to go to any of the playoff games?

Rep. Thoreson I have attended every playoff game. I have attended two of the four national championship games. Since 1980 I have missed three home games. It runs in my blood. My father was employed by NDSU for over 40 years. All of the children in our family went to NDSU.

Blair Thoreson, District 44 Representative

Representative Thoreson: As you know NDSU has recently won their 4th national championship at Division One, which is something I don't know has happened at that level of collegiate football. This is important to recognize on behalf of our state, whether we are fans of the team in Fargo or friends in Grand Forks or whomever. It brings great recognition upon our state. We have seen this with ESPN Game Day coming to our state twice in the last 2 years. There are several great achievements by members of the team other than on the athletic field. I would like to recognize and commend them. The only other issue in the House was a question on the word "dominance" within the bill, whether that constituted approval of any kind of violence. I will leave it to this committee's discretion. I did not come up with the language.

Chairman Flakoll: It is my understanding that Mr. Carson Wentz grew up in Bismarck and maintains a 4.0 GPA, is that correct?

Representative Thoreson: That is correct. It is very commendable.

Senator Marcellais: Did you play for the Bison?

Representative Thoreson: I didn't have the talent, but since 1980, I've made it to all but 3 home football games.

Vice Chairman Rust: I see that 9 of those players earn all-American recognition for their athletic performances.

Representative Thoreson: That is important to point out. Despite the hours they put into extra-curricular activities, they are still focused on gaining a quality education from our institutions.

Chairman Flakoll closed the hearing.

Chairman Flakoll: I will add that I have met with Kyle Emanuel because of my association with Blue Key, which holds some of the brightest, most civic minded students on campus. He is a star both on and off the field and that speaks well of the program. I would also mention that with Mr. Chris Klieman, the head coach, it's amazing that he could take a team that lost more than 20 seniors that had won a national championship with a new coaching staff, and go on and win yet another national championship. That is truly an amazing feat.

A vote was taken: 5 yays, 0 nays, 1 absent.

Senator Davison later votes yay. The motion carries 6-0.

Chairman Flakoll will carry the bill.
