Kyle Davison, District 41 Senator (see attachment # 1)

Senator Schaible: Does the board intend to make a change in membership size?

Senator Davison: No. When I visited with previous school board members, they had asked me why that is in Century Code and thought it should be changed. They have no intention on changing, but think it is appropriate to have the ability nonetheless. Sometimes 9 can get to be a lot of members on a board. Over time there could be a change but as of right with the current Century code, they wouldn't be able to make those decisions.

Vice Chairman Rust: On page 2 with saying "if on when July 1, 2005 the board of any school district contains 3 members, the board must be increased to 5 members.", it implies that we are now with 5 members or more?

Senator Davison: When asking legislative council, the response I've received is that it was date sensitive information that has no purpose to be included any more. One more thing to add is that I sent this out to Superintendent Schatz and asked him to disburse this information to anyone who would have interest. For the record, I never got any objections in my email.

Vice Chairman Rust: right now it is at 9 and has to be 9, so actually what this bill does is gives the Fargo Public School District more latitude depending on citizen vote.

Minutes:

Chairman Nathe: opened the hearing on SB 2229.

Senator Kyle Davison: District 41, introduced SB 2229. The bill is straight forward. It looks at the required number of people on school boards. The bill changed the wording of code so that all of the school boards will be on the same standard. They can set the school board members to 5,7or 9 members whichever your school board or citizens of your community would like. There was no opposition testimony in the Senate. I have not heard any objection to the bill.

Chairman Nathe: Right now it has to be 9 people on the school board according to code?

Senator Davison: Yes it has to be 9.

Chairman Nathe: You just want to bring this in sync with all the districts?

Senator Davison: Yes that is exactly what the bill does.

Chairman Nathe: Is there any chance Fargo may reduce to 5 or 7?

Senator Davison: I don't know the answer to that question but I think the citizens of Fargo should be able to make that decision if they so choose.

Rep Kelsh: On page 2 line 8, if we remove that whole Section does that allow a board to go back to 3 members?

Senate Bill 2229 Testimony January 26th, 2015 Senator Kyle Davison

For the record, I am Senator Kyle Davison from District 41 in south Fargo. I am here in support of SB 2229 and ask for a do pass.

SB 2229 is a simple bill which eliminates the requirement of the Fargo Public Schools to have (9) school board members. This happens by striking lines 1 and 2 on page (3). This change has no impact on its current school board, but does place back into the hands of Fargo citizens the right to petition to reduce the school board similar to all other school districts in North Dakota. On page 2 there are lines which have been stricken from century code and I'm told this is just date sensitive information which was put in back in 2005 and no longer is needed.
