

Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

A concurrent resolution urging Congress to repeal the portions of the federal Affordable Care Act which are overreaching and the portions which are counter to good governance.

Senator Ron Carlisle introduced SCR 4015 to the Senate Human Services Committee. The rule making process is ongoing. There is a study that shows that 2/3 majority of the public things there are parts that are salvageable.

Senator Howard Anderson, Jr. is any survey of North Dakota people that we could refer to or only the national survey.

Senator Carlisle indicated it is only a national survey. It is a few months old, but we do not have North Dakota survey. Public comment shows that Affordable Care Act is not a popular item.

Chairman Judy Lee indicated that we did DO PASS SB 2174, which includes studying the state's health care delivery system. Do you think there is a relation and blended together?

Senator Carlisle indicated yes, much related. Congress should be aware of something.

Chairman Judy Lee wanted to make sure that even if we send to congress, we will be studying in North Dakota.

Paul Sorum, testified IN FAVOR of SCR 4015. (attach #1) His father in law was a prior president of Blue Cross Blue Shield in North Dakota, so he understands the insurance business. He comes to testify that he can't afford health insurance. Mr. Sorum reviewed his policy cost, will cost \$30,621.96 per year. If he struggles with health insurance cost, others will have that same impact. Mr. Sorum compared his insurance cost today to several years ago. If he needed something catastrophic, after 3 years, he feels the cost to pay out of pocket would be less than the cost of insurance. Have yet to see in U.S. constitution that feds can regulate our state's insurance. We may not have sufficient

number of providers that we want, but we have good coverage. We should send message to Washington - we don't want them involved in North Dakota healthcare. Mr. Sorum continued that this is destructive to the people.

V. Chairman Oley Larsen can remember through the election process that our federal senators and representatives were touting repealing the Affordable Care Act. Now that there is a majority of Republicans in the Senate and House, are you hearing that there will be a repeal at the national level.

Mr. Sorum general consensus is yes. A recent poll showed 59% of people in North Dakota want a full or partial repeal. It might get stalled in the senate and the threat of veto by the president. It will be at least after the next presidential election a full or partial repeal.

Senator Howard Anderson, Jr. stated he is also sponsoring this bill. And what was pointed out in the testimony, in order to pay for insurance to pay for the lower income, the rest of us are paying astronomical prices. He supports this for partial repeal to take a look and find improvements. Not sure this will do anything or not. If North Dakota delegation feels there should be repeal, if republicans were all in control, they still may not repeal the whole thing. But some of the things could be fixed.

Senator Dever it is also his understanding that there is bi-partisan support for partial repeal.

Chairman Judy Lee there are things that should have happened 20 years earlier, such as pre-existing conditions, we probably would not have ended up with such an enormous response. There are areas that should be considered.

Senator Dever moved a DO PASS for SCR 4015. The motion was seconded by **V. Chairman Oley Larsen**.

Discussion

Senator Warner agrees there is bi-partisan support. However, this resolution seems negative and doesn't bring up constructive solutions to support.

Senator Axness concurred, that there are areas that need improvement. He doesn't see anywhere in the resolution that states repeal and replace with any constructive adaptations of the bill. Senator Axness agrees there needs to be improvements on the overall bill, but will not support the resolution.

Senator Dever stated that if Senator Axness suggestion is that we replace with repeal and replace, he would strongly support.

Senator Axness indicated "the portions"

Chairman Judy Lee the motion is to move the resolution forward, but amendments can be introduced.

V. Chairman Oley Larsen until they address the essential benefits and taxes that they will take, it will never get better. They will never address those because if they weaken those, then the funding source dries up and it will not support itself. You don't hear a peep from Washington about changing essential benefits or taxes.
