4.5-02.1-01-04. Clinical training requirements.

4.5-02.1-01-04 (1)

1. All clinical training hours must involve the clinical application of addiction counseling and be completed at a training consortium, one or more sites approved by the board, through a university placement or through an individualized training program approved by the board. Clinical training hours must be supervised by a registered clinical supervisor who is either a licensed clinical addiction counselor or a licensed master addiction counselor. Licensed addiction counselors who are registered clinical supervisors may supervise clinical training hours through December 31, 20234.

4.5-02.1-01-04 (6)(c)(2)(a)

(a) The supervision of an intern may be direct or indirect. At least one hour of supervision must be direct, in-person supervision. At least fifty percent of the clinical training hours for an intern must be supervised by either a licensed clinical addiction counselor or a licensed master addiction counselor. Licensed addiction counselors who are registered clinical supervisors may supervise the clinical training hours through December 31, 20234. No more than fifty percent of the clinical training hours for an intern may be accumulated under other professionals who are designated by the registered clinical supervisor, approved by the board, and competent in the area of practice being supervised. The other professional must be registered as a clinical supervisor by the board that licenses that other supervisor.
