NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendment to N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 37-03-01, General Requirements of Licensing, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 16, 2014 in Room 206, of the Department of Transportation Building, 608 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. and will continue until 11:30 a.m. or until no further testimony is offered, whichever occurs first.

The proposed amendment to Chapter 37-03-01, General Requirements of Licensing is to amend section 37-03-01-05 to describe medical conditions related to licensing.

The purpose of the proposed amendment to the N.D. Admin. Code Chapter is to more clearly define medical conditions related to the privilege of holding a motor vehicle operator's license.

The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of Driver's License, Room 240, Department of Transportation Building, 608 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.
