NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Plumbing Board will hold a public hearing to address the proposed amendment to N.D. Admin. Code, Chapter 62-03.1-02 General Regulations, Section 62-03.1-02-02 Uniform Plumbing Code – Exceptions and modifications, Subsection 6 Water supply and distribution, at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 8, 2013, at 1120 College Drive Room 115, Bismarck, ND 58501. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to comply with Federal Law. The proposed amendment addresses the definition of lead free as stated in Public Law 111-380. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota State Plumbing Board at 1110 College Drive Suite 210, Bismarck, ND 58501.
