



### Other Sections in Bill

Section 4 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that, in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds, any other income received from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the Northern Crops Institute is appropriated for the purposes designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2007-09 biennium.

Section 5 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the transfer of appropriation authority between the Main Research Center, the branch research centers, NDSU Extension Service, and Northern Crops Institute.

Section 6 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions for the Northern Crops Institute and report any adjustments to the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 7 of Senate Bill No. 2020 authorizes the carryover of any unexpended general fund appropriation and excess income received by the Northern Crops Institute.
