² Funding added in the executive budget for 2 new FTE Capitol security positions is removed.

³ This amendment adds 2 new FTE trooper positions. The responsibilities for each are as determined by the Highway Patrol superintendent.

⁴ This amendment adds \$200,000 from the general fund and allows the Highway Patrol to spend savings from within its 2007-09 biennium budget for providing salary equity adjustments for troopers and sergeants. This funding is in addition to the agency's share of the statewide salary equity pool. The agency may spend up to \$594,387 in total salary equity adjustments for the 2007-09 biennium. The Human Resource Management Services Division of the Office of Management and Budget is not to consider the additional salary equity funding provided in this Act in its calculation of the Highway Patrol's share of the statewide salary equity pool.

Funding of \$716,936 from the general fund added by the Senate for 4 FTE trooper positions is not included in the conference committee version.

The conference committee removed the section added by the House providing that the Human Resource Management Services Division of the Office of Management and Budget not consider the additional salary equity funding for the Highway Patrol in its calculation of the patrol's share of the statewide salary equity pool.

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
