

Other Sections in Bill

Additional income appropriation - Section 3 provides that in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds any other income from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the Main Research Center, is appropriated for the purposes designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2009-11 biennium.

Transfer authority - Section 4 authorizes the transfer of appropriation authority between the Main Research Center, the branch research centers, NDSU Extension Service, and Northern Crops Institute and provides that any transfers be reported to OMB.

FTE position adjustments - Section 5 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase FTE positions for the Main Research Center and provides that any adjustments be reported to OMB.

Unexpended general fund - Excess income - Section 6 authorizes the continuation of any unexpended general fund appropriation authority or excess income received by the Main Research Center into the 2013-15 biennium.

Appropriations continued from 2009-11 biennium - Section 7 provides that 2007-09 appropriations for the research greenhouse complex project for the Main Research Center are not subject to the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Section 54-44.1-11, and any unspent authority from this appropriation or related revenues are available and may be spent during the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

Emergency - Section 8 provides the appropriation for the research greenhouse complex (\$9,494,581) is an emergency.

Continuing Appropriations

No continuing appropriations for this agency.
