56-01-01-01. Organization of board of optometry.

- History and function. The 1903 legislative assembly passed legislation regulating the practice of optometry, codified as North Dakota Century Code chapter 43-13. This chapter establishes a seven-member board of optometry appointed by the governor. The board regulates the profession of optometry in the state.
- 2. **Board membership.** The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor. Five members are resident registered optometrists and have established optometric practices in the state. Members of the board serve five-year terms.
- 3. **Officers.** The board annually shall elect from its number a president and a secretary. The president shall preside at all meetings of the board. The secretary shall preside in the absence of the president.
