8-05-01-01. Statutory requirements.

In accordance with North Dakota Century Code section 43-03-14, an applicant for registration shall pass an examination in such technical and professional courses as are established by the board, and shall pay the fees required by North Dakota Century Code section 43-03-11.

8-05-01-02. Requirements for NCARB certification.

The board shall not require an architect whose original registration in North Dakota was granted prior to adoption of the requirement for the national council of architectural registration boards certification to be reexamined or to qualify for such certification as a condition for renewal of the architect's registration.
