One-time funding is reduced from \$50,000 to \$25,000 for the Whitestone Hill native memorial and \$50,000 in special funds spending authority is provided. The House version provided \$25,000 from the general fund with a \$25,000 dollar-for-dollar required match and the Senate version provided \$50,000 from the general fund.

This amendment also:

• Transfers \$200,000 from the general fund for the promotion funding from ongoing funding to one-time funding, the same as the House version.

Funding is removed from the general fund for a new historic site supervisor FTE position (\$163,091) and related salary increase (\$6,321), the same as the House version.

Funding from the general fund is reduced to provide a total of \$63,000 for temporary employee salaries and wages and related operating costs of \$37,000 of the Welk Homestead. The House version did not provide funding and the Senate version provided \$85,000 for temporary employee salaries and wages and related operating costs of \$50,000 of the Welk Homestead.

One-time funding from the general fund for the Double Ditch Historic Site repairs was removed from Section 1 of the bill and replaced with a section appropriating \$250,000 from the general fund and \$2 million from the state disaster relief fund to the State Historical Society for the Double Ditch Historic Site repairs and a legislative intent section for Double Ditch Historic Site repairs. The House version provided \$250,000 from the general fund for Double Ditch Historic Site repairs and the Senate version provided \$3.5 million from the general fund for Double Ditch Historic Site repairs.
