PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE AND HOUSE RULES 105

1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.** Senate Rule 105 is repealed.

2 SECTION 2. REPEAL. House Rule 105 is repealed.

> **NOTE:** This proposed rules repeal was requested by the committee as a result of reviewing the memorandum entitled House and Senate Rule Differences and noting that the rules are not necessary because of the 2005 amendments to North Dakota Century Code Sections 23-12-09 and 23-12-10 relating to smoking in public places and places of employment.

3 Senate Rule 105 provides:

4 **105.** No smoking in chamber. No person may smoke in the Senate chamber.

- 5 "Smoke" includes the carrying of a lighted cigarette, lighted cigar, or lighted pipe.
- House Rule 105 provides: 6
- 7 **105.** No smoking areas. No person may smoke in the House chamber or in House
- 8 committee rooms. "Smoke" includes the carrying of a lighted cigarette, lighted cigar, lighted
- 9 pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment.
