## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2005

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs  
2 commission.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in  
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal  
7 funds and other income, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of defraying the  
8 expenses of the Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending  
9 June 30, 1999, as follows:

10	Salaries and wages	\$230,410
11	Operating expenses	34,963
12	Grants	<u>200,000</u>
13	Total all funds	\$465,373
14	Less estimated income	<u>200,394</u>
15	Total general fund appropriation	\$264,979

16 **SECTION 2. ALCOHOL AND DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM - EXPENDITURE -**  
17 **LIMITATIONS.** The moneys appropriated in the grants line item in section 1 of this Act for the  
18 Native American alcohol and drug abuse education program may not be spent for the services  
19 provided by the tribes to administer the program. The local grant recipient is required to  
20 provide match equal to the grant amount with funding or in-kind service.

21 **SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of  
22 this Act includes the sum of \$200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the  
23 children's services coordinating committee for the purpose of defraying the expenses related to  
24 the Native American youth alcohol and drug abuse education program.
