Was read the first time and referred to the Government and Veterans Affairs Committee.

**HB 1125:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to agency authority to expend insurance proceeds; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the Government and Veterans Affairs Committee.

**HB 1127:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 15-28-03, and sections 15-28-06 and 40-21-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to election notices in combined county, city, or school district elections.

Was read the first time and referred to the Political Subdivisions Committee.

#### FIRST READING OF HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

HCR 3008: A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the emergency medical services system to ensure the continued viability of this state's rural emergency medical services.

Was read the first time and referred to the Political Subdivisions Committee.
