A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the secretary of state and public printing; and to amend and reenact section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the secretary of state.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as follows:

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. The annual salary of the secretary of state is fifty-eight sixty-four thousand seven hundred sixy forty-two dollars through dune 30, 2000 December 31, 2001, finty sixty-six thousand four six hundred eighty-four dollars through Decomber 31, 2000 June 30, 2002, and sixty-one sixty-eight thousand one mundred eighteen dollars thereafter.
