A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the secretary of state and public printing; and to amend and reenact section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the secretary of state.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. The annual salary of the secretary of state is sixty four sixty-eight thousand seven hundred forty eighteen dollars through December 31, 2001 2003, sixysix sixty-eight thousand six hundred eighty four ninety-six dollars through dune 30 December 31, 2002 2004, and sixty-eight seventy thousand eighteen seventy dollars thereafter.
