4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in th	is section, or so much of the	
5	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state		
6	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and		
7	other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the		
8	secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending		
9	June 30, 2005, as follows:

SECTION 2. EXEMPTION. The appropriation contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 2 of the 2001 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 for an amount of up to \$105,000, and this amount may be used as state matching funds for federal election reform funding available to the state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.

8 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** The election reform line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 9 and section 2 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
