- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the parks and
- 2 recreation department and the International Peace Garden; to authorize the industrial
- 3 commission to issue and sell evidences of indebtedness for capital projects; to repeal section
- 4 55-08-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to capital projects and revenue bonds
- 5 authorization; and to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 10 other income, to the parks and recreation department for the purpose of defraying the expenses 11 of the parks and recreation department and the International Peace Garden, for the biennium 12 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

6	SECTION 2. BOND ISSUANCE AUTHORIZATION - PURPOSES. Evidences of		
7	indebtedness may be issued for parks and recreation department projects authorized in this		
8	section, at the direction of the director of the parks and recreation department, beginning with		
9	the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2005. The limitation provided in section		
10	54-17.2-23 does not apply to repayments allocable to evidences of indebtedness issued		
11	pursuant to this section. If evidences of indebtedness are issued for the funding of the following		
12	projects, declared to be in the public interest, the industrial commission, acting as the North		
13	Dakota building authority, shall issue evidences of indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2:

29	SECTION 3. BOND ISSUANCE REPAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY. For the retirement		
30	of any evidences of indebtedness issued pursuant to section 2 of this Act, repayment must be		
31	available from state park revenues.		

1 **SECTION 4. SNOWMOBILE FUND.** The sum of \$550,000, or so much of the sum as 2 may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of 3 this Act, is from the snowmobile fund and must be used by the parks and recreation department 4 pursuant to section 39-24-05, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 5 2005. 6 SECTION 5. TRAIL TAX TRANSFER FUND. The sum of \$80,000, or so much of the 7 sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in subdivision 1 of 8 section 1 of this Act, is from the trail tax transfer fund and must be used by the parks and 9 recreation department pursuant to section 39-29-05, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, 10 and ending June 30, 2005. 11 **SECTION 6. STATE PARKS GIFT FUND.** The sum of \$100,000, or so much of the 12 sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in subdivision 1 of 13 section 1 of this Act, is from the state parks gift fund and must be used by the parks and 14 recreation department pursuant to section 55-08-07.2, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, 15 and ending June 30, 2005. 16 SECTION 7. GAME AND FISH OPERATING FUND. The sum of \$122,000, or so 17 much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in 18 subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the game and fish operating fund, or federal or 19 other funds available to the game and fish department, and must be transferred to the parks 20 and recreation department for maintenance, operating, and extraordinary repairs expenses 21 relating to boat ramps at various state parks, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and 22 ending June 30, 2005. 23 SECTION 8. WATER DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND. Notwithstanding section 24 54-27-25, the sum of \$575,287, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the 25 estimated income line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the water 26 development trust fund and may be spent by the parks and recreation department for the 27 purpose of repaying principal and interest on disaster response loans from the Bank of North 28 Dakota, pursuant to section 54-16-13. 29 SECTION 9. REPEAL. Section 55-08-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is 30 repealed.

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- 1 **SECTION 10. EMERGENCY.** The capital assets line item in subdivision 1 of section 1
- 2 of this Act and sections 2 and 3 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
