- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the commissioner of
- 2 university and school lands; to provide a continuing appropriation; to provide for distribution
- 3 amounts from permanent funds; and to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-08.1 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a continuing appropriation from the lands and
- 5 minerals trust fund.

7	SECTION 1.	BASE LEVEL	FUNDING INFORMATION.	The amounts identified in this

16 SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION. The

- 17 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the
- 18 base funding level for the commissioner of university and school lands which are included in the
- 19 appropriation in section 3 of this Act as follows:

1	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the				
2	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from the state lands				
3	maintenance fund and the oil and gas impact grant fund in the state treasury, to the				
4	commissioner of university and school lands for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the				
5	commissioner of university and school lands, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and				
6	ending June 30, 2007, as follows:

8	Operating expenses 648,700				
9	Capital assets 10,000

13	SECTION 4. OIL AND GAS IMPACT GRANT FUND. The amount of \$5,000,000, or so				
14	much of the amount as may be necessary, included in the total special funds appropriated in				
15	section 3 of this Act may be spent from the oil and gas impact grant fund by the commissioner				
16	of university and school lands for the purpose of providing oil and gas development impact				
17	grants and the administration of the oil and gas development impact grant program, for the				
18	biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.				
19	SECTION 5. GRANTS. Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to appropriations made for				
20	oil impact grants in section 3 of this Act.				
21	SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. Upon approval of the board				
22	of university and school lands, the commissioner of university and school lands may transfer				
23	from the contingencies line item in section 3 of this Act to all other line items except the capital				
24	assets line item. The commissioner shall notify the office of management and budget of each				
25	transfer made pursuant to this section.				
26	SECTION 7. DISTRIBUTIONS TO STATE INSTITUTIONS. Notwithstanding section				
27	15-03-05.2 during the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, the board of				
28	university and school lands shall distribute the following amounts, or so much income as may				
29	be available, from the permanent funds managed for the benefit of the following entities:

SECTION 8. A new section to chapter 15-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Lands and minerals trust fund - Continuing appropriation. There is appropriated annually the amount necessary to pay from the lands and minerals trust fund all principle and interest to the common schools trust fund on any loans made from the fund to the developmentally disabled loan fund program nos. 2 and 3.
