16	SECTION 4. COLLECTIONS FROM COUNTIES - GENERAL FUND REVENUE. The		
17	secretary of state shall collect \$76,100 from counties to reimburse the general fund for a portion		
18	of the state matching requirement provided for federal election reform funds for the biennium		
19	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007. All funds collected by the secretary of state		
20	under this section must be deposited in the general fund.		
21	SECTION 5. EXEMPTION. The appropriation contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of		
22	chapter 2 of the 2001 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 for an		
23	amount of up to \$105,000, and this amount may be used as state	matching funds for federal	
24	election reform funding available to the state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and		
25	ending June 30, 2007.		
26	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the Nor	th Dakota Century Code is	
27	amended and reenacted as follows:		
28	54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. The annual salary of the secretary of state is		
29	sixty-four thousand seven hundred forty-two dollars through December 31, 2001, sixty-six		
30	seventy thousand six hundred eighty-four fifty-nine dollars through June 30, 2002 2006, and		
31	sixty-eight seventy-two thousand eighteen eight hundred sixty-one	e dollars thereafter.	

- **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-09-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- **54-09-08.** Secretary of state's general services operating fund. The secretary of state's general services operating fund is a special fund in the state treasury. Moneys in the fund are to be used pursuant to legislative appropriations for the provision of services under section 16.1-02-15, subsection 6 of section 41-09-94, subsection 9 of section 54-09-04, and sections 54-09-10 and 54-09-11. At the close of each fiscal year biennium, the secretary of state shall transfer any unobligated balance remaining in the fund exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars to the general fund.
- **SECTION 8. EMERGENCY.** The election reform line item in subdivision 1 of section 3 and section 5 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
